Snow Removal & Snow Dumps

When it snows outside, Public Works gets to work. To alleviate any concern or calls - calls such as “when is my road being done?” we wanted to let you know what the process is:

- Priority is given to paved roadways, hills and bus routes.
- The municipality alternates after the priority routes to do the north part of the municipality then south, or south then north.
- If more snow is received up in Anglin, McPhee and Elk Ridge than at Christopher or Emma Lake, the crews prioritize and roll out service accordingly.

The municipality is large in area. Efforts are made to provide the quickest, safest and most economical service, so please be patient. **Public Works asks that ratepayers bring their Greenland Waste bins off the road as soon as possible after garbage pickup so snow removal can be done efficiently.**

Snow dumps are located at the Emma Lake Transfer Station (see below for hours) and the overflow parking for Bell's Beach.

Going Out Hunting, Hiking, or Ice Fishing? Leave a plan!

[AdventureSmart](#) is a good online service that offers a template for what information you should leave with a friend or family member before going out into the wilderness. The basic questions they should know the answers to are:

- Exactly where you are going? Where are you starting, and where are you ending? Try using [Google Maps](#) to share the route you are taking.
- How long do you plan to be out? When are you leaving?
- Can you be contacted while out?

- How much extra time might you take before it's time to worry?

Hypothermia and wildlife are serious risks in this area of Canada. With -30° C windchills, mild hypothermia and frostbite can occur within 30 minutes of outdoor exposure!

Other tips for outdoor adventuring:

- If you are ice-fishing, bring a second set of clothing and a blanket. Wet clothing can turn mildly cold weather into extreme conditions very quickly.
- Bring a walking stick! It's a great help if you sprain an ankle or get stuck in some deep snow.
- Wear an item of bright orange clothing so you are easy to spot for hunters. Consider wearing reflective gear.
- Have other adventuring gear close at hand, such as a first aid kit, pocket knife, flashlight, food, bear spray, or flares.

Winter Transfer Station Hours

The transfer station continues with their winter hours, open 10AM-4PM on Monday, Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday. These hours will remain until the end of April, 2019.

The transfer station is closed on December 25th and 26th for Christmas, as well as January 1st. They are open on January 2nd, 2019.

Business Licences

The 2018 business licences expire on December 31st, 2018. The 2019 licence must be obtained before work commences in 2019 in the District of Lakeland.
