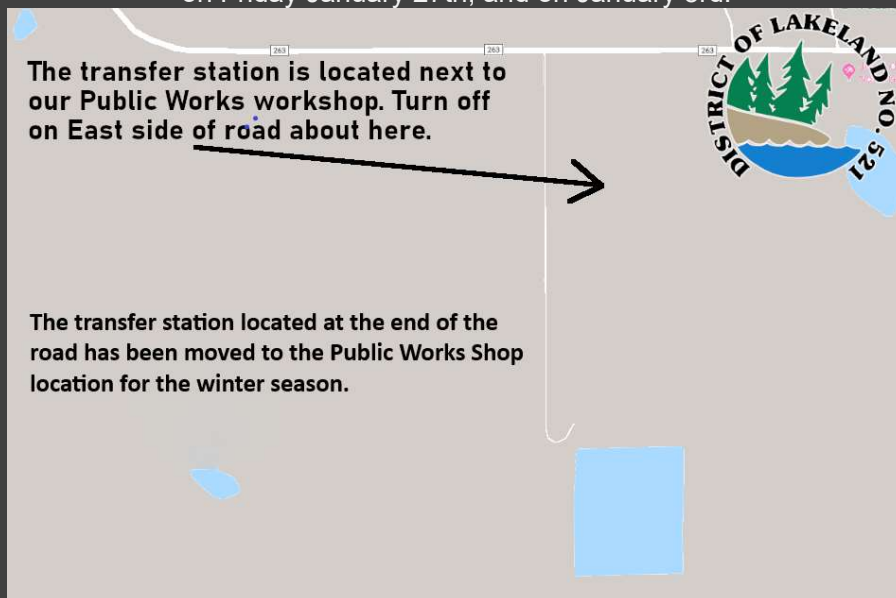
PAD Program

The District now has a Pre-Authorized Debit (PAD) program that allows taxpayers to make **equalized monthly payments** for taxes as opposed to paying one lump sum payment. Payments are withdrawn on the 1st of each month from your bank account.

Winter Transfer Station Hours

The transfer station continues with their winter hours, open 10AM-4PM on Monday, Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday. These hours will remain until the end of April, 2020. The transfer station is closed on December 25th, as well as January 1st. They are open on Friday January 27th, and on January 3rd.

See an orange tag on your waste bin? Our Public Works employees are now doing inspections of bins to ensure compliance with the bylaw. On the tag is a checklist with any violations noted.

The tag could indicate: the bin was heavier than 90kg (200lb), the bin was left on the road outside of collection time, the bin was overfilled, or the bin contained prohibited items, recyclables, hazardous waste, or construction material. On the tag is a reminder of what items are permitted, but you can read the [full list on our website](#).
