The EAC is guided by the District's [Environmental Management Plan](#), and works to improve specific trouble areas such as lake water quality and shoreline destruction. As well, the EAC consults with ratepayers, government agencies, and non-government organizations such as [PARCS](#) as required. The EAC is looking for one - possibly two - new members. Safety Tips for the Holiday Season

- **Drive to arrive.** Plan for winter travel by ensuring you have appropriate clothing, winter tires, sharing your travel plans with someone before you leave, and leaving early so you don't feel rushed. [Winter car kit advice.](#)
- **Drive sober.** It's never worth it to drink and drive; check stops and increased patrols are coming. If you suspect an impaired driver, call 9-1-1 when it is safe to do so.
- **Check your Heaters.** Carbon Monoxide is a deadly odourless and colorless gas. Check your detectors in your home, and make sure never to leave a car warming up in an enclosed space. Service your furnace annually. Use a CO detector in your ice fishing shack and ensure you are properly ventilated.

- **Snowmobiling.** The season for snowmobiling is starting soon, and you can use the provincial Snowmobile Association's [online resources](#) to book safety training, check trails, and ensure your sled is registered. Contact information for the [Lakeland Snowmobile Club](#) is available on the website.



Snow Dump Sites have been designated in two areas of the District where residents can haul clean snow from driveways and yards;

- Emma Lake Transfer Station - drive to end of landfill road South of the Transfer Station, snow dump is located West of old landfill site;
- Overflow parking lot across from Bells Beach.

Pushing or dumping snow onto or into Public Reserves, across road ways or road allowances, and private property (without written permission) is prohibited.

Development Packages

Make sure to get a development permit before doing any work on your property. If you are unsure if you need a development permit, please call the office!

Packages for different types of development are available on our [website](#); these include sand, gravel, trees, fences, new dwellings, detached garages, demolitions or moving of buildings, decks, and more.
