ATV usage in provincial parks is limited to trails that have been signed and designated for that purpose, as per [The Parks Regulations \(1991\)](#).

This form outlines the rules and responsibilities associated with riding an ATV within Great Blue Heron Provincial Park.

Check each box to acknowledge that you have read and will comply:

- You must have a valid driver's license to operate an ATV.
- You must have 3rd party liability insurance to ride on Crown land and be able to produce a copy of your insurance if requested by a peace/enforcement officer.
- Children between the ages of 12 and 16 must be supervised by a person who has held a continuous/valid license for one year.
- Personal protective equipment must be worn and includes: helmet, eye protection, long pants, long sleeves and boots.
- ATVs must be washed off and cleaned prior to riding in the park to avoid the spread of noxious weeds and/or invasive species.
- ATVs are only permitted on designated trails within the park. You must stay on these trails at all times.
- ATVs are not permitted in the following locations:
 - o Campgrounds and boat launch areas,
 - o Valley View and Anglin Lake hiking trails,
 - o On the Sundogs road (NE of Anglin Lake),
 - o On the trails surrounding Oscar Lake.

REMEMBER:

Your responsible riding will help to ensure the future of recreational ATV use in the park.

**Weather conditions can change abruptly, impacting trail conditions.
The Park Manager reserves the right to close any/all trails without prior notice.**
