	Personal protective equipment must be worn and includes: helmet, eye protection, long pants, long sleeves and boots.
	ATVs must be washed off and cleaned prior to riding in the park to avoid the spread of noxious weeds and/or invasive species.
	ATVs are only permitted on designated trails within the park. You must stay on these trails at all times.
	ATVs are not permitted in the following locations:
	 Campgrounds and boat launch areas,
	 Valley View and Anglin Lake hiking trails,
	 On the Sundogs road (NE of Anglin Lake),
	o On the trails surrounding Oscar Lake.
