

June 2023 Council Meeting Update

Delegations:

- The Grade 8 class from the Christopher Lake School attended Council meeting to give a presentation to explain the school's fundraiser called the Colour Me Fun Run. This fundraiser is the school's largest fundraiser and raised over \$19,000 last year. They are aiming to beat that goal this year. The tailgater BBQ starts at 11:00 a.m. All community members are welcome. The kids race around an obstacle course where they are sprayed with water and have powdered colours thrown at them. There will be some other attractions as well, such as a dunk tank. Council and staff were encouraged to get involved by attending the event.

Bylaws:

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd readings were given to Bylaw 7-2023 being a bylaw respecting the regulations and use of golf carts. Waiting on SGI for final approval.
- 1st reading was given to Bylaw 8-2023 being a bylaw to amend 17-2013 known as the Zoning Bylaw to add Car Washes under:
 - o C-1 Resort Commercial District Development as a discretionary commercial use; and
 - o C-2 Retail and Service Commercial District Development Standards as a permitted commercial use.
- A public hearing will be held on July 12, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. to receive submissions regarding the proposed Zoning Bylaw amendment to permit Car Washes in Commercial Zoning Districts.

Reports, Discussion, and Actions:

- Building/Development monthly permit report was received.
- Public Works provided an update on Trees, Beaches, Roads, Equipment, Transfer Station, Lagoons and drainage. Summer staff positions were filled.
- Protective Services provided their monthly report and provincial and inter-agency updates.
- Administration provided an update. Administration was authorized to start the proceedings to request title for properties with a registered tax lien. A \$500 donation was made to the Christopher Lake School for the Color Me Fun Run. The District will be replacing beach and park garbage bins with animal proof ones over the next couple of years.
