



REQUEST FOR TENDER
**SUPPLY, AND APPLICATION OF CALCIUM CHLORIDE/
MAGNESIUM HYDROXIDE SOLUTION**

1. INVITATION TO TENDER The District of Lakeland No. 521 is inviting tenders for the application of calcium chloride / magnesium hydroxide solution for the purpose of road stabilization on approximately 46 kilometers of gravel roads within the District of Lakeland No. 521.

2. SCOPE OF WORK The scope of work includes, but is not limited to:

- Supply and apply a Calcium Chloride /Magnesium Hydroxide Solution to approximately 46 km of road for stabilization purposes.
- Ensure the proper equipment and safety measures are in place to conduct the spraying operation.
- Provide all necessary labor, materials, and supervision for the project.
- Ensure compliance with all environmental and safety regulations.
- Maintain a high standard of workmanship throughout the project duration.
- Work closely with the Public Works Manager to ensure all required roads have been completed.
- Map of application areas can be provided by request.

3. PROJECT LOCATION The work will be conducted on various gravel roads within the District of Lakeland No. 521. A detailed map and specifications will be provided upon request.

4. QUANTITY & DELIVERY SCHEDULE

- Work commencement: After Spring Road Bans have been removed. June 1st 2025.
- Completion deadline: June 15, 2025.

5. CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS

- Proven experience in supply and application of a Calcium Chloride /Magnesium Hydroxide Solution
- Required licensing and permits for hauling and roadworks.
- Adequate equipment and workforce to complete the project on time.
- Compliance with all relevant safety and environmental regulations.

6. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS Interested bidders must submit the following:

- Company profile with relevant experience.
- List of equipment and personnel.
- Detailed price breakdown on attached supply and application tender form.

- Proof of liability insurance and relevant certifications.
- References from similar projects.

7. EVALUATION CRITERIA Tenders will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Price competitiveness.
- Experience and past performance.
- Ability to meet the required timeline.
- Compliance with specifications.

8. TENDER ACCEPTANCE

- The Municipality reserves the right to refuse to accept any or all tenders, and the lowest tender will not necessarily be accepted
- Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, any tender may be rejected which is incomplete, obscure, or irregular.
- The Municipality reserves the right to cancel the acceptance of any tender at any time before execution of the contract by all parties without any liability against the Municipality.
- Municipality reserves the right to consider tenders with minor omissions provided that the bidder, if successful in the tender awarding, can rectify the omission within five (5) days of the tender being awarded.

9. COMMENCEMENT AND COMPLETION OF WORK

- Time will be of the essence of the Contract made with the successful bidder and the contractor will be required to comply strictly with the dates specified, subject to the terms of the contract.
- 20% of the total tender will be held until the Municipality can approve the job completion.

Supply and application of Calcium Chloride / Magnesium Hydroxide Solution for the purpose of road stabilization on approximately 46 kilometers of gravel roads within the District of Lakeland No. 521.

Requirements:

1. Municipality is not liable for moving or set-up costs.
2. Coordination of the spreading is to be through the Public Works Manager.
3. Contractor is to spread according to the supplied road map which will be supplied by the municipality.
4. Calcium Chloride/ Magnesium Hydroxide Solution spraying information is to be submitted to the municipality. Original copies must be returned when the corresponding invoice is submitted.
5. Contractor agrees that the sub-contracting of Calcium Chloride/ Magnesium Hydroxide solution may only be done with the approval of the municipality.
6. Municipality will retain the right to determine the amount of Calcium Chloride/ Magnesium Hydroxide solution applied.
7. Municipality may suspend Calcium Chloride/ Magnesium Hydroxide Solution spraying at any time, due to adverse road or weather conditions, or unsatisfactory performance by the contractor.

8. Contractor agrees to obey the speed limit on all municipal roads at all times.
9. This agreement applies to the year 2025 only.
10. Haul dates must be after the removal of the spring road bans and before June 15, 2025; unless a different time frame is approved by the municipality.
11. Upon tender reward by the municipality, this document will comprise the written agreement between the parties.
