The District of Lakeland No. 521 Council held its regular meeting on **Wednesday, September 9, 2026**, at the Municipal Office in Christopher Lake. The meeting included departmental reports, a public hearing, community dock discussions, annual appointments, and regular administrative and financial business.

Reports & Operations

- **Municipal Enforcement – Mark Irwin:**
 - Council received the Municipal Enforcement Report.
- **Delegation – Roxanne Dyck:**
 - Met with Council to discuss community dock processes.
- **Development – Kerry Potter:**
 - Designated one community dock space to each of 92 Jacobson Drive, 98 Jacobson Drive and 204 Bay Drive West, with the spaces remaining with the properties while they continue to be assessed as lakefront.
 - Approved a discretionary accessory use for a shipping container at 30197 Highway 2 following a public hearing where no written or verbal submissions were received.
 - Council received the Building/Development Report.
- **Public Works – Jessica Georget:**
 - Council received the Public Works Report.

Administration & Operations

- Authorized an application to the Provincial Safety Fund Grant for the boardwalk portion of the walking trail and four speed signs—two at Neis Beach and two at Anglin Lake.
- Received an update regarding RFNow.
- Council received the Administration Report.

Administrative & Financial Decisions

- Approved payments totaling \$822,726.44, including payroll of \$61,133.56.
- Received the Statement of Financial Activities and Bank Reconciliation for the period ending August 31, 2026.

- Established a Human Resources Committee consisting of the Reeve, two voting members of Council and the CAO as a non-voting member.
