



CALL FOR TENDER

Heavy Duty 4x4 Dual Rear Wheel Truck- White

The District of Lakeland No. 521 invites tenders for the supply and delivery of one (1) new, current-model-year heavy-duty 4x4 dual rear wheel truck, equivalent to a Ford F-450 Super Duty DRW, for municipal Public Works operations. Equivalent makes and models will be considered where they meet or exceed the minimum specifications below.

1. Minimum Vehicle Specifications

- 4x4, dual rear wheel (DRW) configuration with a minimum 14,000 lb GVWR.
- Regular Cab or Crew Cab; configuration must be suitable for municipal operations.
- Heavy-duty gasoline or diesel engine; minimum 7.3 L gasoline engine or equivalent heavy-duty diesel.
- Automatic transmission with tow/haul mode.
- Heavy-duty cooling system, alternator and dual-battery system.
- Engine block heater and cold-weather starting capability suitable for Saskatchewan winter conditions; remote start if available.
- Heavy-duty front and rear suspension and rear axle; limited-slip or electronic locking rear differential.
- Four-wheel disc brakes or equivalent heavy-duty braking system, ABS, electronic stability control and traction control.
- Commercial-grade all-terrain or all-season tires, heavy-duty wheels and full-size spare tire.
- Manufacturer standard safety equipment and driver-assistance systems for the model year.

2. Towing, Deck and Exterior Equipment

- Minimum factory-rated towing capacity of 15,000 lb.
- Manufacturer heavy-duty trailering package, including factory trailer brake controller, integrated trailer wiring, 7-pin connector, heavy-duty receiver hitch and trailer sway control or equivalent.
- Trailer tow mirrors with integrated lighting.
- 10-ft flat deck with lighting and tie-down points.
- Heavy-duty front and rear bumpers, tow hooks, mud flaps, and running boards or side steps.

3. Interior Requirements

- Durable commercial-grade interior; vinyl seating and rubber/heavy-duty flooring preferred.
- Air conditioning, heater/defrost, power windows and door locks, cruise control and tilt steering.
- AM/FM audio with Bluetooth, USB charging ports and backup camera.

4. Warranty, Service and Delivery

Tender submissions must include:

- Manufacturer full, powertrain and corrosion warranty details, including any additional coverage.
- Local authorized dealership/service location and estimated availability of replacement parts.
- Expected delivery date.

5. Tender Submission Requirements

Each tender must clearly identify:

- Make and model, complete vehicle specifications, and engine/transmission specifications.
- GVWR, payload capacity, towing capacity, wheelbase and overall dimensions.
- Warranty information and delivery timeline.
- Total purchase price, including all applicable fees and taxes.
- Available options or upgrades.
- Any variance from the minimum specifications in this tender.

6. Evaluation

Tenders will be evaluated on overall value, including purchase price, compliance with specifications, towing and payload capability, warranty, local service availability, delivery timeline, and suitability for municipal Public Works operations.

The District is not obligated to accept the lowest-priced tender and reserves the right to reject any or all tenders.

7. Submission Deadline and Contact

Tenders must be submitted by October 19, 2026. Late tenders will not be considered.
